

Addressing patient challenges with rare diseases

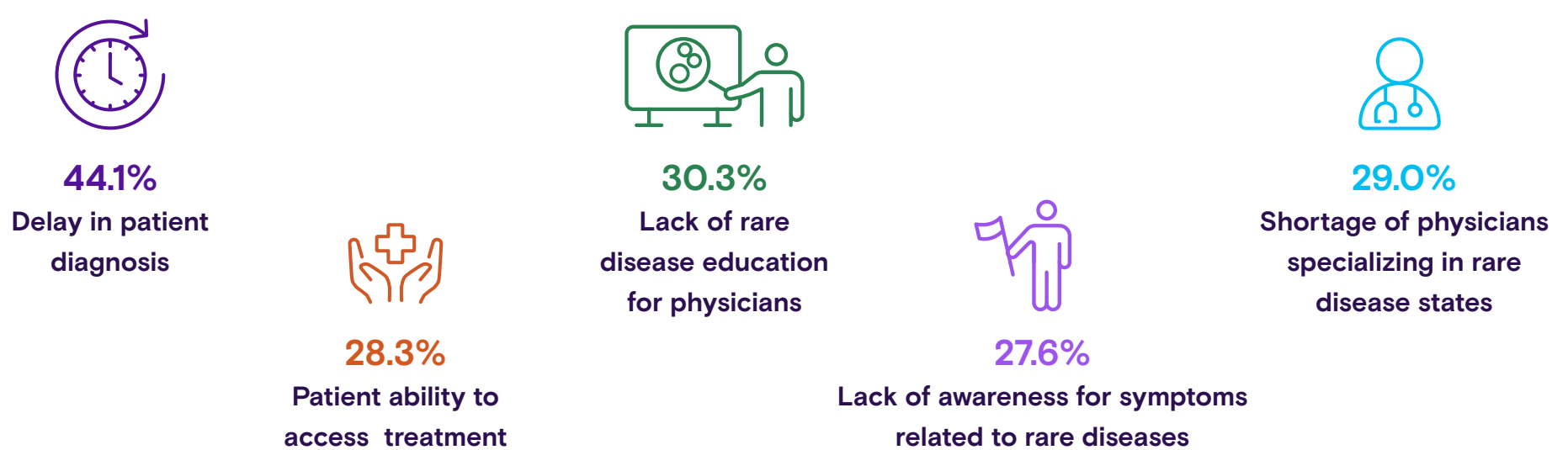

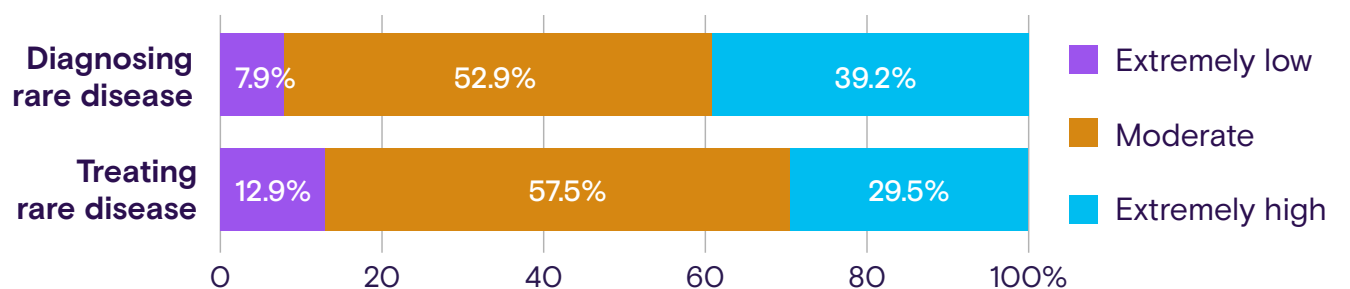
The challenges patients and providers face

More than one-third of providers highly rate their organization's ability to diagnose rare diseases.



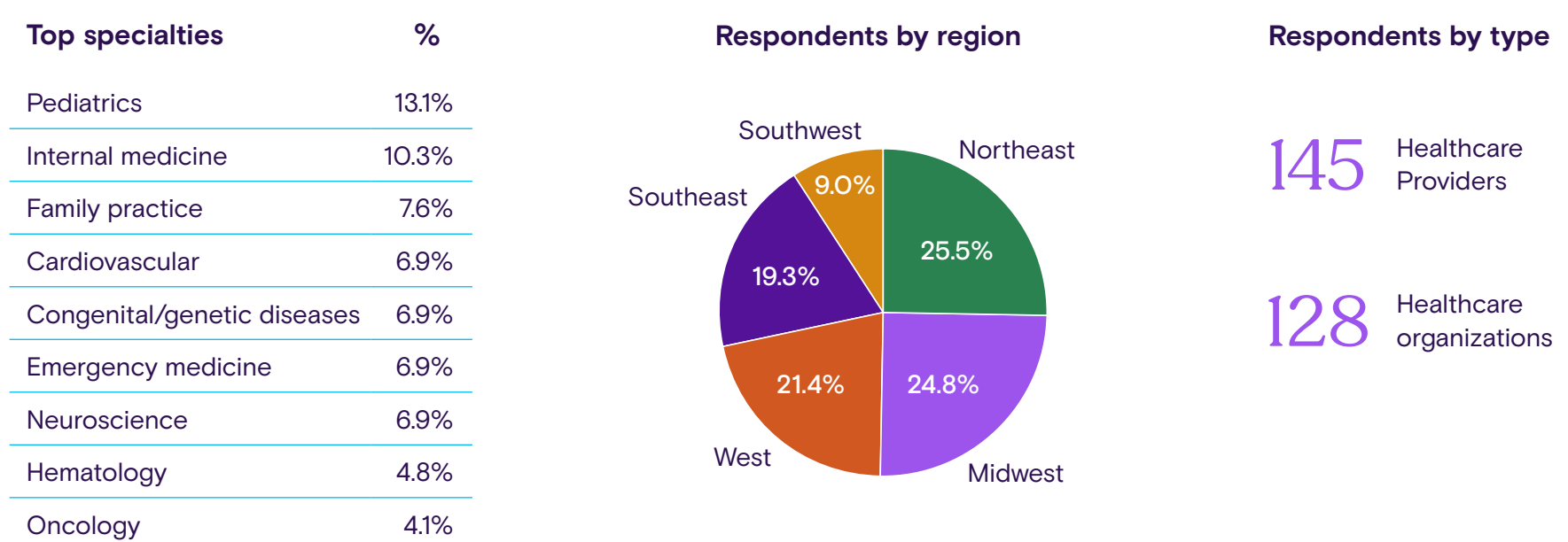
Moving the needle
